Here are the **details of the Caribbean Pack**:

Premium Pack

- 12 V electrical windlass with foot control
- cabins curtains, cockpit and saloon cushions
- fresh water outside shower on port float transom
- holding tank
- LED navigation lights, LED interior lights
- rigid cockpit roof
- bow thruster with one dedicated battery
- mooring kit (3 lines and 6 fenders), 50 m cable + 60 m chain + 20 kg Kobra anchor
- 230 V network: 6 x 220 V outlets + 25 m shore line
- service battery charger, engine battery charger, 230 V / 12 V - 2 000 W / 80 A combi converter
- audio Fusion Apollo 770
- antifouling with epoxy primer

Outside comfort:

- Cockpit tent (removable)
- cockpit tent extension with mosquito net
- bimini helm
- helm station canvas bimini protection (removable soft windshield and side enclosures)

Inside comfort:

- Bolon carpeting in the saloon
- plexiglass separation between saloon and port cabin
- Installation of three additional portholes: one porthole on the central front panel, one side porthole in the master cabin on the starboard side and one side porthole on the port cabin

Comfort pack

- Master cabin: canvas storage replaced by woodwork furniture unit, wooden solid rail (along the bed), Bolon flooring
- Forward cabin: headboard Alpi panel, shelves in Alpi, Bolon flooring
- Port cabin: shelves in Alpi, Bolon flooring
- Saloon: Bolon flooring, saloon ceiling in Alpi, solid wood rails in front of the chart table, six storage bins
